ATTRACTIVENESS	The artwork was beautiful and patiently done; it was as good as hard work could make it.	With a little more effort, the work could have been outstanding; lacks the finishing touches.	The student showed average craftsmanship with a lack of pride in finished work or a hurried, last-minute product.	The student showed poor craftsmanship; evidence of laziness or lack of understanding.
